DESIRED/PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: MFA in Fashion Design, must be from an accredited institution of higher education. Record of research, scholarly and/or creative activity, involving students whenever possible. Evidence of effective teaching. Experience with Fashion Design software. Strong art background and ability to teach in related fields of Art (e.g. Foundations of Art: Drawing, 2-d Design, 3-d Design, Color).

In addition to teaching, duties include student advisement and committee service for the Department of Art, College of Arts and Letters, and the University.
