**POSITION: TENURE-TRACK ASSISTANT PROFESSOR**

**STARTING DATE: Fall 2008**

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. or ABD in Philosophy. Area of specialization: Open. Area of competence: At least one of the following: applied ethics, East Asian philosophy, feminist theory, Latin American philosophy, or race theory. Candidates should have a record of or potential for scholarly activity, involving students whenever possible, as well as a demonstrated potential for effective teaching using a variety of methodologies. Candidates should also demonstrate an ability or interest in teaching in a multicultural, multiethnic campus. A Ph.D. from an accredited institution of higher education is required for tenure.**

**DESIRED/PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: The Department has a preference for candidates who, in addition to their specialization, have interests in teaching courses that satisfy breadth requirements for undergraduates. In addition to introductory lower division courses, the department also offers a broad array of upper division courses that are in areas of applied moral and social philosophy. Completion of the Ph.D. is strongly preferred before Fall 2008.**

**DUTIES: In addition to teaching, duties include student advisement and committee service for the Department, College of Arts and Letters, and the University.**
