Students who complete every course on this plan will have completed a minimum of 194 units.

\*\*NSS 301 (2 units) fulfills the Transition to Higher Education course and should be taken during the first quarter. However, this requirement has currently been suspended.

\*\*\*MATH 230 is an alternative to MATH 207 but is offered only in SPRING quarters.

<sup>+</sup>Students may take classes during the Summer Quarter to finish earlier or to take fewer units each quarter.

<sup>++</sup>Students must take 2 diversity (d) courses as part of GE from Blocks C, D, E or Upper Division Theme.

**CROSS OUT COURSES THAT STUDENT OFFICIALLY RECEIVED CREDIT FOR TRANSFER WORK.**

If working student (working 20 hours or more per week) who desires to pass courses on first attempt, after determining which requirements remain you should not take more than 2 courses per quarter.

The 3 GE BLOCK D courses must be from three different departments and the 3 GE BLOCK C courses must be from three different areas!

**DO NOT TAKE GE THEME COURSES FROM YOUR MAJOR DEPARTMENT OR CROSS-LISTED COURSES TO MAJOR DEPARTMENT COURSES.**
