After the introductory sequence, students should take the courses in chronological order when possible (i.e., early British literature before later British, early U.S. literature before later U.S., etc.). We recommend that Engl 492 and Engl 494 be taken in the student's last year. A SAMPLE schedule is provided in the template above.
