The School of Nursing, California State University, Los Angeles, has scheduled an evaluation of the Baccalaureate and Master's programs by the Commission of Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). CCNE is a recognized national accreditation agency that ensures quality and integrity of baccalaureate and graduate education programs in preparing effective nurses.

This is an opportunity for students, alumni, faculty, and the practice community to provide written input to CCNE for a comprehensive evaluation by the on site evaluation team. The evaluation visit is scheduled April 16-18, 2012. The agency requests that written and signed third-party comments are submitted directly to CCNE by March 17, 2012.

CCNE will share third-party comments with members of the evaluation team prior to the visit, but at no time during the review process are these comments shared with anyone from the School of Nursing or University. The evaluation team will consider third-party comments that relate to the nursing program's compliance with the CCNE accreditation standards. The standards are published by CCNE and can be accessed through their website.
