

# PLEASE NOTE:

## THERE WILL BE NO LATE ADDS SUMMER QUARTER, 2009.

As you may well be aware, our state is currently facing an unprecedented budget crisis and consequently cuts for all state programs are imminent.

Therefore, all departments at CSULA were recently mandated to reduce enrollment in summer classes, many of which you were registered for or trying to register for this summer quarter.

We understand that this presents a hardship for you; however, these cuts are beyond our control.

If your class was cancelled and you cannot add a class that you need, here are some suggestions for you:

- You can try adding a class that you need by going to the first day of class and seeing if the professor has room to add you.

**Please note:** Professors are not allowed to add matriculated students that exceed the class enrollment limit. Therefore, the only way a professor can add you to a class is if another student drops from that class. The enrollment limit has nothing to do with whether or not there are seats available in that classroom.

- Talk to your advisor about doing a possible course substitution for the class that you needed.
- Try taking the course (if it is 100 and 200 level only) at a community college. Go to [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) to see if a course is transferable.

### **Credit for Community College Course Work**

A maximum of 105-quarter units (70 semester units) earned in a Community College will be allowed towards the units required for graduation. Neither upper division credit nor credit for professional education courses is allowed for community college work. (Source: <http://catalog.calstatela.edu>)
