1.2 On June 19th we received the following is the response from Vice President Garcia to the questions raised about parking by Senator Mendell at the Senate meeting of May 14, 2002:

Question:

How many faculty members who have paid for parking have received parking tickets over the last five years and how many students similarly have tickets over the last five years who have paid for parking stickers?

Response:

This data is not available as parking citations are issued to vehicles and not to individuals. We do not have the ability to know who is driving a car and what their status is here on campus. Nor do we have the ability to track parking citations by status and cross-reference by those who have purchased decals or permits.

Question:

How many ticket protests were received and what percentage of them were reversed in the last five years?

Response:

In the last five years (FY 97-98 to present), 27 percent of all citations issued were dismissed on appeal (2,877 of 10,555).
