5. Liaison Reports

ATS - D. Cardoza reported on that Golden Eagle Territory (GET) went live this past Saturday, and have received a significant number of visits. Suggestions were made to put a link to GET on the Student Computing Resources web page, and that letters go out to faculty to announce GET in their classes. It was also suggested to do demonstrations in some of the large lecture classes and in the Intro to Higher Ed classes.

6. 24-Hour Access

Suggestions for 24-hour access included wireless hubs, and broadband/high-speed access. Other suggestions were for lounges where laptops can be plugged in, extend length of time laptops can be checked out, and provide portable printers that can be checked out. There was a discussion of how to deal with college/department specific software and the future of the campus modem pool.

7. Technical Proficiency for Students

The basic items discussed for technical proficiency were email access, Internet access, database and a multimedia software package. The Student Scholars Training Program sends schedules to faculty who require computer use in their courses and CBT CD's are available to students. W. Sternal indicated that there is a component in the 100 level courses where they emphasize technical proficiency. J. Wiebe indicated that CCOE will offer a 1 unit assessment course.
