5. A resume that includes a portfolio list and all teaching experience, if any.
6. A portfolio of creative work in the TVFT MFA Option you are applying for:
  - Dramatic Writing: a writing sample of up to 15 pages of a script/play
  - Performance/Acting: a DVD (NTSC) performance reel of up to 15 minutes (including two contrasting monologues totaling four minutes)
  - Production: a DVD (NTSC) production reel of up to 15 minutes

*Note: Interviews/Auditions may be required of candidates.*
