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### ***Requirements for All International (F-1/J-1) Students!***

#### ***Reporting Requirement:***

- All international students admitted to Cal State L.A. (including students coming from another U.S. institution) must report to the International Office no later than the first week of classes during the first quarter at CSULA. You must bring your original CSULA I-20, previous school's I-20 for transfer students, passport and I-94 card to the International Office.

#### ***Mandatory International Student Orientation:***

#### ***Health Insurance Requirement:***
