REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION COURSES (52-54 UNITS)

Note: Students must apply to the Charter College of Education and be accepted before they will be allowed to take the required professional education courses listed below. The Blended program is designed for students to take their credential courses *at the same time* as they take their undergraduate courses in Liberal Studies, not after they have completed all of the undergraduate requirements. This means that students must plan ahead to take the necessary exams and take care of the appropriate paperwork in order to apply to the Charter College in a timely fashion. Students should go to a Group Advisement for how to apply to the Charter College of Education during the first quarter of their junior year (or for transfer students, during their first quarter on campus). For more information on Group Advisement sessions, students should visit the Charter College of Education Office for Student Services on the 2nd floor of King Hall (KH D2078). Students must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 in their last 90 quarter units to be eligible for admission to the Charter College. Students who do not have the minimum GPA should consider taking Option II and raising their GPA before graduation; after graduation, the students can then apply to the Charter College with the improved GPA. Students can also apply for special action admission if they have a minimum 2.5 GPA and have passed all sections of the CSET.
