

# **Dale Weaver, Ph.D.**

Dale Weaver is Associate Professor in the School of Social Work at California State University, Los Angeles, and Director of Research at the Child Welfare Training Center. He teaches research methods, child welfare and macro social work practice. He received his PhD in Social Welfare from UCLA in 1994 after a long career as a social work practitioner working with the chronically mentally ill, the homeless mentally, and homeless and runaway youth. He has conducted a number of evaluation research projects in the areas of welfare-to-work and public child welfare. Recent research projects have addressed turnover among child welfare workers and implementation issues of the Indian Child Welfare Act.
