The Youth Enrichment Project is a program of the Pat Brown Institute and it consists of an integrated approach to assist inner-city youth in attaining a higher quality of life than presently available to them. The Youth Enrichment Project's programs utilizes peer leadership training, mentoring and peer education to increase educational opportunities and prevent and/or reduce youth involvement in violent and criminal behavior.

The goal is to improve graduation rates and college attendance of marginalized students by providing academic and personal opportunities to strengthen the life skills of youth that are at risk of dropping out of high school, participating in gangs, or involving themselves in violent behavior.

**Skills and Knowledge:** Candidate should possess a high level of interpersonal skills and have a history of working in a self-directed environment.
