Guidelines for the Presentation

In general, the presentation will be divided in 3 parts:

Part I. Causes of the Crisis

- Indicate the factors that contribute to the crisis.
- Suggest the type of crisis.
- How did the crisis permeate to the aggregate economy?

Part II. During the Crisis

- The scope of the crisis (decrease in Real GDP, unemployment rate, bank collapses, etc.)
- Response of policy makers to the crisis. Clearly describe the monetary and fiscal policies implemented to address the crisis.

Part III. Post-Crisis

- Outcome of the implementation of monetary and fiscal policies.
- How did the country emerge from the crisis?
- Mention any intervention from international institutions.

There is no minimum or maximum number of slides. Just keep in mind that your presentation should not take more than 30 minutes, including questions.

A good source of data for just about any country is its Central Bank. The IMF also keeps statistical data for some countries. Numerous websites provide data and analysis of the various crises.
