Tuition and fees must be paid before registering for classes unless a student is fully awarded financial aid grants, loans or scholarships, is sponsored by a third party or is participating in a payment plan. Non-payment or incomplete payment of tuition and fees may result in a hold placed on your student account, possible disenrollment from your current classes, and forfeiture of tuition and fees already made. Any partial tuition payments made will be applied to the prorated tuition and fees charges.
