Installment Payment Plan (IPP) - 2 Payments

Defer the cost of your Tuition Fee for an enrollment fee of \$22.00. The first installment is due prior to registration, and the second installment is due 30 days from the issued agreement date.

Available through April 1st, 2016, before 5:00 p.m.

Management Payment Plan (MPP) - 3 Payments

Spring 2016 Quarter’s Tuition and Fees

Divide the cost of your tuition and fees into three installments for an enrollment fee of \$35.00 for one term. The first payment for Spring 2016 term is due February 1st, 2016. *If your enrollment appointment is earlier than February 1st, then the first payment is required to register for classes.* The last day to use this plan for Spring 2016 is March 1st, 2016, however both the February and March payments must be made to enroll at that time.
