PROJECT OBJECTIVE

Develop a Microsoft Power BI database approach for executive reporting, supported by business rules, conceptual and logical designs, implementation planning, and administration guidance.

STUDENT CONTRIBUTION

The team clarified data policies and reporting needs, modeled entities and relationships, developed a logical schema, considered physical implementation, and organized an approach for reports and database monitoring.

ARTIFACTS PRODUCED

- Business rules, assumptions, and constraints
- Conceptual design and entity-relationship diagram
- Logical schema and physical design plan
- Database implementation and reporting approach
- Administration guidance, final report, and presentation

COMMUNITY VALUE

The YMCA received a structured database and reporting concept that could support more consistent executive information and future implementation decisions.
