Cal State LA is one of the best regional universities in the nation, according to the 2017 U.S. News & World Report Best Colleges edition released Sept. 13.

Cal State LA was ranked #14 among public regional universities in the West, a jump from last year's #18 ranking.

"Our reputation for excellence continues to grow," said Cal State LA's President William A. Covino. "Our rise in national rankings is an indicator of our success in carrying out our mission and practicing our values."

Cal State LA was ranked #61 among western universities, moving up from #63 a year earlier.

U.S. News also highlighted Cal State LA's affordability. Those who received bachelor's degrees from Cal State LA have the fourth lowest debt among graduates of schools in the West.

The report singled out two Cal State LA programs as among the nation's best undergraduate programs. Both have been ranked by the magazine for more than a decade.
