### **Grants and Gifts**

#### **Arkansas State University**

Arkansas State University (ASU) alumnus Neil Griffin made a \$10 million gift to his alma mater. In recognition of the largest individual gift to an academic program, the ASU Board of Trustees approved naming the Neil Griffin College of Business. The gift will endow a range of scholarships, professorships and enhancement funds for the operations of the college. Griffin has made provisions for a follow-on estate gift that will provide significant future enhancements. Read more

California State University, Los Angeles has been awarded a nearly \$1 million grant from the National Science Foundation (NSF) to increase degree completion and career readiness among students in engineering and computer science majors. The grant is funded through the NSF Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (S-STEM) Program. Read more
