Representatives from the Task Force who developed the plan will be visiting each of the campuses to present the plan. On October 29th Jackie Kegley, Chair of the Statewide Senate and Professor of Philosophy at Cal State Bakersfield, Gary Hammerstrom, Associate Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs, CSU, and Susan Meisenhelder, President of the California Faculty Association, will meet with our Senate to present the plan and take questions.
