At is meeting of March 28, 2007, the Executive Committee approved by Executive Action deleting lines 29-33 from the proposed modification to the policy on Acceptable Levels of Part-Time Faculty Employment approved by the Academic Senate on November 28, 2006 and returned unsigned by the President on February 2, 2007. The President's memo states: "After review, I am returning the proposed policy document to you unsigned. Consistent with the faculty collective bargaining agreement, only employment within the CSU is monitored; therefore, lines 29-33 are not appropriate."

Also on March 28, 2007, the Executive Committee approved by Executive Action deleting the Guidelines for Technologically Mediated Courses that appear in Appendix K of the <u>Faculty Handbook</u>. The Executive Committee took the action because President has approved the policy on Modes of Delivery which now appears in Chapter IV of the <u>Faculty Handbook</u> and supersedes the Guidelines.

These Executive Actions will stand approved at the close of the Senate meeting on April 17, 2007, unless there is a request to add either of them to the agenda before that date. The documents are at the Secretary's table if any Senators would like to review them.
