- 6.4 The Flint motion was approved as amended.
- 6.5 It was m/s/p (Faust) to amend document 06-15.1 by deleting the sentence on lines 13 to 15 that reads: Students meeting this criterion may include in this allowance up to 9 units of 500-level courses.
- 6.6 It was m/s/p (Faust) to amend lines 17 through 19 of document 06-15.1 by deleting the words graduate adviser and the program coordinator/chair/director for the program/department/division/school in which the master's degree is to be taken and inserting INSTRUCTOR TEACHING THE COURSE, THE STUDENT'S ADVISER, AND THE COORDINATOR/CHAIR/DIRECTOR OF THE PROGRAM/DEPARTMENT/DIVISION/SCHOOL OFFERING THE COURSE and by deleting the sentence on lines 22 and 23 that reads: Enrollment in courses also requires instructor consent.
- 6.7 It was m/s/p (LaPolt) to amend lines 10 to 12 of document 16-15.1 by deleting the words adequate for admission to the program toward which the courses would normally be applied and inserting OF **2.75**.
- 6.8 It was m/s/p (LaPolt) to amend lines 12 to 13 of document 06-15.1 by deleting the statement: If the student is admitted to that program, the student may petition to have those courses applied toward that degree.
- 6.9 The recommendation was APPROVED as amended (06-15.1). (Senator Tikkanen requested that his nay vote be recorded.) Copies of the document are available in the Senate Office.

- 7.4 It was m/s/ (Faust) to amend document 06-16 by deleting the phrase chair of the on lines 9 and 18; deleting the phrase or director of the on line 19; and inserting a backslash between the words "division" and "school" on line 19.
- 7.5 It was m/s/p (Tikkanen) to substitute a motion to delete the phrase chair of the program/department/division/school and insert HEAD OF THE ACADEMIC UNIT on lines 9 and 10; delete the phrase chair of the program/department/division or director of the school and insert HEAD OF THE ACADEMIC UNIT on lines 18 and 19; insert the words HEAD OF THE before the word "student's" and ACADEMIC UNIT after the word "student's" on line 23; and delete the phrase program/department/division/school on line 24.
- 7.6 The substitute motion was approved.
- 7.7 The recommendation was APPROVED as amended (06-16). Copies of the document are available in the Senate Office.
