- 11. 11.1 Chair Warter-Perez reminded the body that the policy on the floor contains revisions from motions passed at the last meeting.
  - 11.2 It was m/s/ (Peterson) to delete from lines 6-7: "COURSES NOT OFFERED SUCCESS-FULLY FOR A CERTAIN TIME PERIOD WILL FIRST BE INACTIVATED AND THEN DELETED" and move from line 7-8 to line 11 after the word "INACTIVATED": "A COURSE IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE BEEN OFFERED SUCCESSFULLY IF IT MEETS THROUGH THE CENSUS DATE."
  - 11.3 Senator Flint suggested as a friendly amendment to merge lines 4 28 into one paragraph. No objections were raised.
  - 11.4 The motion as amended passed unanimously.
  - 11.5 The recommendation was APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY as amended (14-17).
- 12. 12.1 It was m/s/ (Cleman) to replace current policy in the Faculty Handbook with the updated Code of Conduct & Ethics for Student-Athletes.
