Sex Offense/Fondling

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, University Police is giving notice of the following incident:

- **Summary:** On April 18, 2016, at approximately 1:18 p.m., while waiting for an elevator on the 6th floor of the Engineering and Technology building, the victim felt a subject pat him on his buttocks with both hands. The victim stepped onto the elevator and noticed the subject also enter behind him. While inside the elevator, the subject attempts to strike up a conversation with the victim. The victim then exits the elevator on the 3rd floor and proceeds down the hallway. A few moments later, the victim decides to take the stairwell down to the lobby but is surprised to find the same subject in the stairwell. The victim rushes by the subject and down the stairwell to exit the building.
- **Description:** The victim described the subject as a dark skinned male Latino, 35 years old, 5-feet 11-inches tall, approximately 170 pounds, with a medium build and short wavy hair. The subject was last seen wearing clear rectangular glasses, dark clothing and was holding a newspaper.
- **Location:** Engineering & Technology Building, 6th floor
