## ROBBERY

| Summary: | On Monday, January 28, 2019, at approximately $4: 15 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m} .$, a Cal State LA student was <br> walking in the neighborhood adjacent to campus, near Dobbs Street and Warwick Avenue, <br> when two suspects approached him and asked to borrow his cell phone. One of the <br> suspects snatched the phone from the student and began running toward an awaiting <br> vehicle. The student gave chase but was confronted by that suspect with a handgun. Both <br> suspects got into a white 4-door Lexus sedan and left the area with a third suspect who <br> was in the vehicle. The vehicle was last seen driving eastbound on Valley Boulevard <br> toward the 710 Freeway. |
