Installment Payment Plan (IPP) - 3 Payments

Installment Payment Plan enrollment fee is \$33.00*. The first installment is due prior to registration, the second installment is due 30 days from the issued agreement date and the 3rd installment is due 60 days from the issued agreement date. Available through December 5th, 2017.

Management Payment Plan (MPP) - 4 Payments

The Management Payment Plan enrollment fee is \$35.00**. The first payment for spring 2018 term is due November 1st, 2017. If your enrollment appointment is earlier than November 1st, then the first payment is required to register for classes. The last day to use this plan for spring 2018 is December 1st, 2017, however both the November and December payments must be made to enroll at that time.
