Students have been be able to request since early January

<u>Automated Nudges to Undergraduate Graduation Candidates - Done</u>

- Based on mass 'Degree Audits' notifies candidates who are not running clear with inprogress reports.
- First notification after census for Spring candidates to promote timely resolution or moving graduation date before fall appointments.

<u>Final Exam Schedule – Week of March 26</u>

Year Round Pell Grant


- > Eligible students were sent a notification and now have been packaged.
 - About 1,900 eligible for 'remaining Pell' due to enrolling part-time this year.
 - > Almost 12,000 eligible for 'year round' Pell which requires a minimum 6 unit enrollment
 - Remember to refer to the Summer 2018 Pell Grant Website which includes a cost worksheet http://www.calstatela.edu/financialaid/summer-pell-grant.

Summer 2018 Cost Worksheet.

Input the amount of your Full-Time Spring 2018 or Summer 2018 Pell Grant award from your financial aid package in the blue box. The table below will then reflect in the yellow highlighted column how much you would need to pre-pay in order to enroll in that number of units for Summer 2018. Students receive a maximum of 12 full-time equivalent semesters of Pell eligibility of their bachelor's degree. The last column indicates the amount of lifetime eligibility that would be used.



Using Pell Grant for Summer Pell Grant Redistribution/Flexibility




Benefit: Expedite Graduation

- Student A: Finish in 5 years, 12 units per Semester, No Summer
- Only 10 FT Semesters used, 2 terms of Pell Grant eligibility remain




- Student B: Finish in 4 years, 12 units per Semester, 6 units each summer
- Only 8 FT Semesters + 4 HT Summers use=10 total terms used. 2 terms of Pell Grant eligibility remain. 1 year of added earning potential.



Degree Planner

- Created at University of Arizona within PeopleSoft
- CSULB led CSU implementation with Chico and San Marcos
- Oct 2014 First Majors Live
- 11 CSU campuses live LA, Bakersfield and Channel Islands are wave 5 of the CSU implementation.



Degree Planner - Key Features

- Recommendations based on ideal timely progression
- Plan is based on the student's current progress and updates based on registration, course completions, transfer credit, and substitutions. Adds extra requirements when needed such as calculus preparation.
- Plan is customizable by the student and advisor including unit load, shopping -style course selection and drag-anddrop re-arrange courses.
- Plan is integrated with degree audit, schedule planner and registration.
- What-if capability for change of major, add a major/minor.

First things first...

- Who will be able to use the Planner?
 - Must be on semester curriculum for GE and Major (Fall 16 or later)
 - Students cannot have any Cal State LA Quarter Credit
 - Major must be built and tested

NOTE: Screen shots in this presentation include samples from other institutions for illustration purposes.

What is it doing?



- Runs the Academic Requirements Report to see what is already met by any means.
- Constructs a recommended plan based on the Advising Road
 Map setting unit preferences and course priorities.
- Adjusts based on 'co' and 'pre' requirements built within the plan.
- Ensures courses are placed in terms when typically offered.





Let's do the "Shuffle"

- Reprioritizes classes unless course is 'locked'
- Relooks for 'co' and 'pre-reqs' may result in moving courses later
- Checks courses for when they are 'typically' offered - may result in moving courses later
- Attempts to move courses earlier to promote timely graduation if there is room in a term based on units and 'typically' offered




