Notes

- ENGL 102** is required before a student is eligible to take the WP or complete UNIV 401. In order to be admitted to the Charter College of Education, students must pass the WPE or UNIV 401. Students must pass the WPE by the time they complete 135 units, or will have a hold placed on their enrollment until they do so. Most ENGL 102 equivalents will also meet the GE A3 (Critical Thinking) requirement.
- COMM 150** or an equivalent course in public speaking is required for all teaching credential candidates by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. This course will also satisfy the GE A2 (Communication) requirement. Not all GE Speech courses will satisfy the CTC requirement, notably courses in group dynamics or interpersonal communication.
- CHDV 140 or equivalent** will be required of all students entering ULRN as of Fall 2016. Students are encouraged to include CHDV 150 or an equivalent course in their GE preparation at the community college.
- MATH 110** is required before a student is eligible to take EDEL 417. The course is generally in addition to your GE A4 (Math) course. Some Community Colleges have groups of courses equivalent to MATH 110, 115 and 225 that you may also take – they are good preparation if you anticipate having difficulty with the CSET Math subtest. This course will not be required for students entering the credential program as of Fall 2016.
- If you take an equivalent to ENGL 102, COMM 150, CHDV 140 or MATH 110 after you matriculate at CSULA, your equivalent course grade **MUST** be submitted to Records and Student Services on an official transcript as soon as you complete the course.
