Note 1: A3 is the prerequisite for WPE;

Note 2: ECON 2010 or ECON 2020 is double-counted as one course in GE D;

Note 3: ECON 3060 and MGMT 3080 are both double-counted in UD GE;

Note 4: Two Civic Learning (*cl*) courses are required in GE. BUS 101 counts one and the other must be completed in UD GE;

Note 5: Two diversity courses (*d*) are required in GE. At least one must be a Race/Ethnicity (*re*) course;

Note 6: Two writing intensive courses (*wi*) are required in GE. One of them must be in the major (BUS 3050);

Note 7: Total number of units required for the degree: 120 units.

FIN 303 should be taken as early as possible, as it is a prerequisite for most finance courses, including FIN 3250 and FIN 4390.

Choosing your GE courses correctly and FIN 3320 and two other finance courses (e.g. FIN 4030, 4340, 4370, 4470, 4500, 3310, or 3350) as your free electives, you can also complete a minor in Finance. (FIN 4300 and 4370 are recommended, but challenging.) Please see a CBE Adviser.
