








Freshmen 6 Year Graduation Rate by **Incoming Cohort Year**




Freshman 6 year Graduation Rate by Campus





Transfer 2 Year Graduation Rate by Incoming Cohort Year




Transfer 2 year Graduation Rate by Campus




Transfer 4 Year Graduation Rate by Incoming Cohort Year





Retention Rates by Incoming Cohort



% of FTF Returning after 1st Year by College



% of FTF Returning after 1 Year




% of FTF Returning after 1 Yr by Gender


1 Year FTF Retention % by Cohort Year and URM/NURM






