On Thursday Oct. 19 at 10:19 AM, our campus and housing complex will participate in the Great California ShakeOut, simulating an earthquake. Afterwards, the fire alarms will sound and we'll evacuate. Remember to comply with the evacuation alarm and the directions of Housing and Residence Life staff. The Evacuation Site for Phase I and Phase II is in the far Northeast corner of Lot 7. The evacuation location for GEA is on the grassy median on Mariondale, just South of GEA. A Cal State LA or Housing and Residence Life staff member will give you instructions after your arrival to the evacuation sites. Remain in these designated areas until you are accounted for and given permission to leave the area and re-enter your apartment.
