

1 **Guidelines for the Appointment of Adjunct Professors**

2 (Senate: 7/3/84; President: 8/16/84; Editorial Amendment: 9/00, 8/01)

3 In cases where the university may benefit from the appointment of a professional person or a
4 distinguished member of the community, such persons may be designated as adjunct professors. The
5 special conditions and expectations for these honorary appointments will be determined by the
6 department/division/school for each individual appointee. The criteria upon which the determinations are
7 based vary depending upon the background of the appointee, the nature of the discipline represented,
8 and the needs of the university.

9 The President shall appoint adjunct professors for a one-year position based on the recommendations of
10 the department/division/school personnel committee, the chair of the department/division or director of the
11 school and the college dean. These appointments shall be reviewed annually and may be renewed.

12 Adjunct professors shall be identified in the university catalog by department/division/school and shall be
13 entitled to library privileges, parking privileges, and a faculty identification card, and, as appropriate, office
14 space. Use of office space will be arranged by the department/division chair or school director.
