## NOTES FOR GENERAL EDUCATION LOWER DIVISION COURSES

- A minimum C grade in A1, A2, A3, and B4 classes is required. A 'C-' grade is not acceptable.
- AM requirement consists of 2 courses: 1 US History and 1 US Constitution/State & Local Govt. Transfer students that have completed the US Constitution requirement and not the State & Local Government requirement, may take POL 2000 in place of POL 1000.
- A minimum C grade average in general education is required of all students following the Fall 2016 or later catalog.
- Students must pass the Writing Proficiency Exam (WPE).
- Civic Learning/Community Engagement Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level. These courses are designated as (cl) after the course listing.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course. These courses are designated as (re) and (d) after the course listing.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) courses, with at least one in their major. These courses are designated as (wi) after the course listing.
