ABACC Education and Curriculum Specialist

Janaina Maudonnet is a Ph.D. in Education from the University of Sao Paulo. As part of her doctoral studies, she was a visiting scholar at the Center for the Study of Democracy at the University of California Irvine. She also has a Master of Arts in Education and a Bachelor of Science in education from the University of Sao Paulo. She is a certified preschool teacher by Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) and an accredited teacher by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. In addition, Janaina is a Specialist in Citizenship and Human Rights in the Education System from the Complutense University of Madrid in Spain, and a Specialist in Public Policies of Early Childhood from the Organization of Ibero-American States.

Since 1994, she has been working in Early Childhood Education. She worked as a teacher for 15 years in public preschools in Sao Paulo, Brazil, and as a trainer for more than 10 years at the Educational District in the same city. In addition to her work with children, she was a college professor at Community Colleges in Brazil teaching Curriculum and programs in Early Childhood Education and Foundations of Early Childhood Education. She has also written several articles about training programs and public policies in Early Childhood Education.
