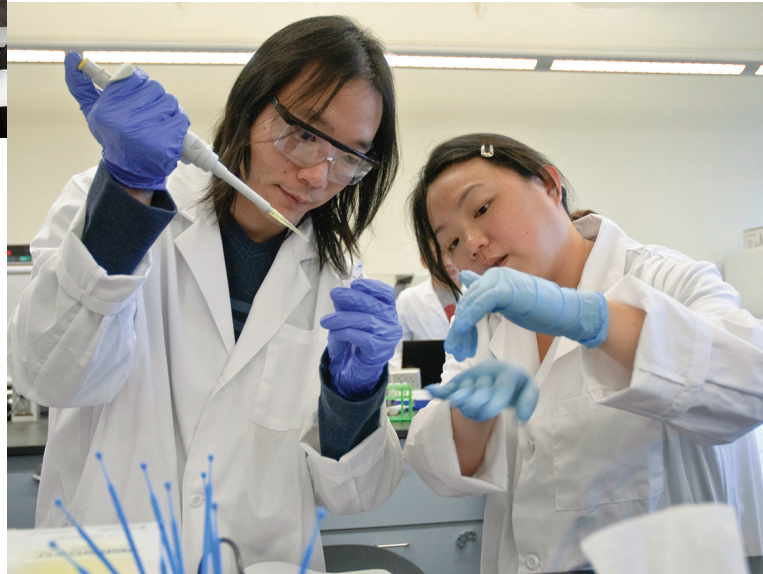
- Take undergraduate and graduate courses on an American university campus taught by Cal State LA faculty with a diverse group of nearly 28,000 students

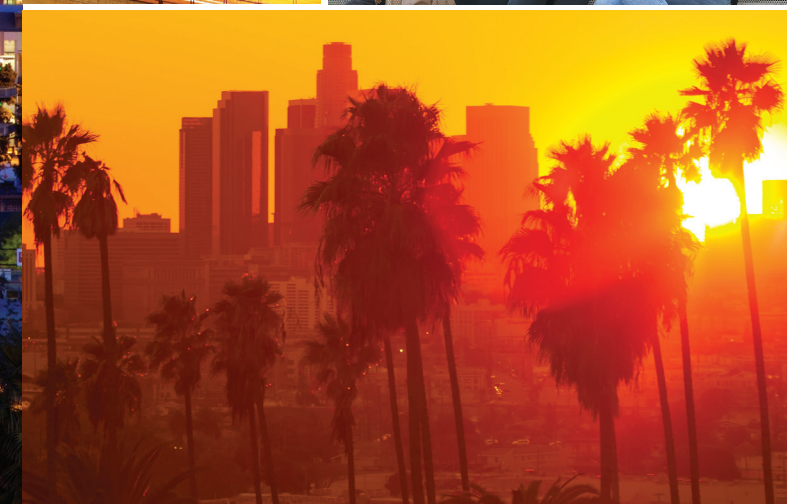
