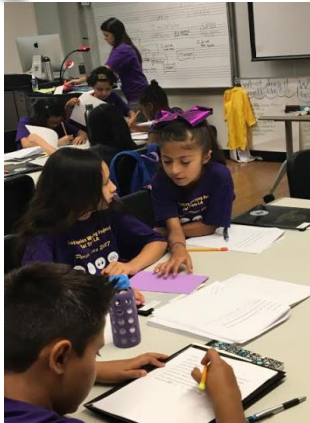

Students Entering Grades 1st-7th

The Young Writers' Camp - Student writers will be introduced to the strategies of professional writers and to a variety of writing forms. Writing workshops are also blended with activities in other creative arts, including: drama, music, drawing, and painting. Staff members include experienced oral storytellers who will teach students the traditional art of weaving their own stories. Students will tour the campus and visit the college bookstore and have access to a broad range of stimulating facilities: the art museum, the music department, and the library.

Students Entering Grades 8th -12th

Secondary Writing Institute - Student writers focus on essays and creative writing. Essay writing includes: brainstorming, outlines, paragraph structure, thesis statements, supporting ideas, and closing paragraphs. Students' essay writing assignments from school can be utilized during the class. Creative writing focuses on novelettes, poetry, memoirs, and journaling from video writing prompts. Other writing activities include author study sessions and writing groups. As a culminating project, students create a digital portfolio that will showcase all of the writings completed during the course.
