**Details of External Credits** - the left side columns show the source (Transfer School) courses and units while right side columns show the CSULA equivalent and accepted (converted) units. The **CAAR** only applies courses that have a CSULA equivalency. To convert semester units to quarter units you multiply the semester units by 1.5.

Many courses articulate and you will see an equivalency under the **CSULA Course** column. However, credit may be entered by the admissions office as a transfer code. Below is a table of codes that are used to apply credit. The CAAR recognizes these codes and applies them into the proper area for credit.
