Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Student must complete either two race/ethnicity (re) courses or one diversity (d) course and one another race/ethnicity (re) course.

Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) courses, with at least one in their major. These courses are designated as (wi) after the course listing.

With advisor approval, students may substitute 3 courses of statistics or 6 units of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) or other courses that focus on quantitative analysis.
