To be eligible for a loan, you must be enrolled at least **half-time** as an undergraduate or 2nd bachelor's (6 units), graduate (6 weighted units), or teaching credential student (6 units).

Graduate Students: 500 series level graduate courses have a weighted factor of 1.5 (i.e. a 500 level course for 4 units will be weighted to 6 units). Courses below 500 are not weighted, thus enrollment in two or more courses may be required to meet the 6 units. Refer to "Study Load" information published in the *Schedule of Classes* for information on courses 596, 597, 568, 599, 699, and 900.
