Health Requirements

ALL NEW STUDENTS

MEASLES AND RUBELLA (M/R) IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT:

Students Who Are Exempt From Requirement:

Students born in 1982 or later (1983, 1984, etc.) who attended a public school in California.

Students born prior to December 31, 1956.

Students Who Are **Not** Exempt From Requirement:

Students born between January 1, 1957 and December 31, 1981.

Students born after December 31, 1981 who did not attend a California public school.

Non-exempt students must provide written proof* of measles and rubella immunizations to the Student Health Center. Laboratory confirmation of Measles and Rubella immunity may be submitted in lieu of proof of vaccination. ***Students will not be able to register for a second quarter until this requirement has been satisfied.***

HEPATITIS B IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT:

Students Who Are Exempt From Requirement:

Students born in 1982 or later (1983, 1984, etc.) who attended a public school in California.

Students Who Are **Not** Exempt From This Requirement:

Students born in 1982 or later who **did not** attend a public school in California.

Non-exempt students must submit written proof* of immunization against hepatitis B to the Student Health Center. Immunizations consist of a series of three injections. Laboratory confirmation of hepatitis B immunity may be submitted in lieu of proof of immunization. ***Students will not be able to register for a second quarter until this requirement has been completed.***

*Acceptable proof is a written document signed and dated by a licensed health care provider.

Student Health Center Measles/Rubella & Hepatitis B Immunization Clinics:

Mondays thru Thursdays 9 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. - 5 p.m. and Fridays 9 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. No appointment is necessary. There is no charge for Measles/Rubella immunizations.

Students who have acceptable proof of immunizations:

Mail, FAX or hand carry verifications to the SHC. Mailing address: Student Health Center, Cal State L.A., 5151 State University Drive, L.A., CA 90032-8411. **Include your name, CIN, date of birth and quarter for which first entered.** FAX number: (323) 343-6557. The Student Health Center is located just South of the Career Center and East of the Biological Science Bldg. Parking in metered lot C is recommended.

BE IMMUNIZED OR FIND YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORDS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. A registration hold will be placed on all new students who do not complete this requirement prior to registering for a second quarter. This will prohibit access to STAR and may cause considerable delay in your eligibility to register for classes.

Don't delay!

Processing of your records could take up to three working days.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In addition to the Measles/Rubella & Hepatitis B requirement (see reverse side), all new and returning International Students must provide acceptable proof of negative Tuberculosis skin test or negative chest x-ray taken within the past year.

Prior to registering for classes for the first time, all new and readmitted international students must provide the Student Health Center (SHC) with the following information before in order to register:

1. **Tuberculosis (TB)** Written proof* of a negative TB test (Mantoux) or chest x-ray, taken within one year of your STAR registration date.

*Acceptable proof is a written document signed and dated by a licensed health care provider.

Student Health Center TB Testing Clinics will be every Monday and Tuesday 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday and Friday 9 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Students who are given a TB skin test must return in two or three days to have their skin tests checked by a (SHC) nurse. **There is no charge for this service for registration clearance.**

Students who have acceptable proof of TB may mail, FAX or hand carry verifications to the SHC. Mailing address is Student Health Center, Cal State L.A., 5151 State University Drive, L.A., CA 90032-8411. **Include your name, CIN, date of birth and quarter for which clearance is requested.** FAX number: (323) 343-6557.

Processing of your records could take up to three working days, therefore, please plan ahead to clear this registration hold. Failure to do so may cause considerable delay in your eligibility to register for classes.

The Student Health Center is located just South of the Career Center and East of the Biological Science Bldg. Parking in metered lot C is recommended.
