BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS
TRAINING SCHEDULE

The Student Health Center offers American Heart Association CPR training for current and incoming Cal State L.A. nursing students (photo I.D. and proof of current enrollment / acceptance into nursing program required). Renewal skills testing is also available (see BLS Healthcare Provider Online Renewal Course information below). Trainings and testing are conducted in association with the CPR Training Center (an American Heart Association Training Center). Call the Student Health Center at (323) 343-3340 for more information or to register for a training or testing session. All trainings and skills testing sessions take place in the Health Promotion and Education Center, Student Health Center, Room 215.

Important notes:

- 1) Pre-registration is required. We encourage you to sign-up for a desired training date as soon as possible as space is limited and classes are typically filled 2-4 weeks in advance. You may register for a class or schedule a skills testing appointment by calling the Student Health Center at (323) 343-3340. Please note: enrollment in a class or skills testing appointment are subject to availability and are not confirmed until one of our instructors contacts you and informs you that your desired training date / appointment is available. You may also register/schedule an appointment in-person in the Health Promotion and Education Center, Student Health Center, Room 215.
2) Pre-payment at least one week in advance of training date is required. If fee payment is to be mailed it is the student's responsibility to ensure that payment is mailed with sufficient time to arrive at the Student Health Center at least one week prior to training date. Failure to pay appropriate training fee at least one week prior to training date can result in loss of training reservation. The Student Health Center is not responsible for loss of training opportunity due to late/lack of payment. Photo I.D. and proof of current enrollment / acceptance into nursing program are required with payment.

The Student Health Center only accepts cash or check (please make checks payable to the CSULA Student Health Center and include your 'CIN' and 'CPR training' on the memo line). Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers (Fee: \$40.00)

Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers teaches CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction skills for adult and pediatric victims. It includes training on two-rescuer CPR and the use of bag-masks and automated external defibrillators (AED). Course length is approximately 4½ hours (includes a break). Successful completion of skills testing and written examination are required to receive a BLS Healthcare Provider Course Completion Card.

BLS Healthcare Provider Online Renewal Course (Skills Testing Fee: \$15-30)

This course is a review of CPR skills for the healthcare provider. Healthcare providers complete 12 mandatory checkpoints and the written exam online (www.americanheart.org • \$17.50). Skills testing is then conducted by appointment. Photo I.D., proof of current Healthcare Provider certification, and the BLS Healthcare Provider Online Renewal Course Completion Certificate are required for skills testing. BLS Healthcare Provider Course Completion Cards are issued to those who provide appropriate documentation and successfully complete skills testing.
