## MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS Housing Services

Proof of a negative tuberculosis test or chest x-ray is required of all residents. The attached *Tuberculosis Verification* form must be completed and returned prior to the move in date.

Instructions:

### Steps

1. If you already have valid written proof of a negative TB test or chest x-ray taken within the past year, you may attach it to the Tuberculosis verification form.

If you do not have valid written proof of a negative TB test or chest x-ray taken within the past year, you need to have the *Tuberculosis Verification* form completed by a health care provider.

2. Hand-carry or fax the *Tuberculosis Verification* form, along with any attachments, to the Student Health Center. FAX (323) 343-6557.
3. A Student Health Center nurse will verify the acceptability of the verification and forward the approval to the Residence Life and Housing Complex representative.

**NOTE:** TB tests and chest x-rays are available to students, faculty and staff at the CSULA Student Health Center for a nominal charge. The TB test is given Mondays and Tuesday 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 - 4:30 p.m. and read two days later during these same hours. No appointment is necessary. Chest x-rays are available Monday thru Thursday during the hours listed.
