Located on the River Main about halfway between Frankfurt and Nuremberg, Wurzburg nestles between vineyards and forests. Wurzburg is both a thousand-year-old town and a vivacious modern university city. The great medieval fortress Marienberg dominates the skyline, overlooking the beautiful Old Town with its architectural masterpieces from many different periods.
