To comply with California State University Executive Order 622 which requires that international students and exchange visitors obtain and maintain insurance coverage for health, medical evacuation and repatriation during their period of enrollment at CSULA in amounts at least equal to those specified by the Department of State (DOS) and NAFSA: Association of International Educators, your insurance policy needs to meet the following criteria:

- 1) The policy is valid until at least September of the following year or the end of your program, whichever is sooner;
- 2) The medical benefit is at least \$100,000 per condition and the co-payment does not exceed 25%;
- 3) The repatriation benefit is at least \$7,500;
- 4) The medical evacuation benefit is at least \$10,000;
- 5) The deductible does not exceed \$100 per illness or injury;
- 6) The policy must be funded in the United States;
- 7) The policy must not require more that a six-month, treatment-free period prior to coverage and must not require more than a six (6) month waiting period.

You must submit **an English Language copy of your policy benefits** with this petition to IPS so that the Insurance Broker of Record can verify your policy coverage.
