

CSU SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING THE WINTER 2011 ADMISSION APPLICATION PROCESS

The initial application filing period for admission to the Winter 2011 term begins on August 1, 2010. However, because the California Governor and Legislature have not yet adopted a budget, at this time the CSU does not know how many students it can admit. While each campus will process your application conditionally, no offer of admission will be sent until we know more about the budget, including whether funding to the CSU will support an increase in enrollment.

Once a budget is adopted, each campus to which you apply will notify you about your options. If the budget provides funding to increase CSU enrollment, each campus will finalize its review of your admission eligibility for the application term. If the budget does not provide additional funding to increase CSU's enrollment, you will have the option of either requesting that your admission application be changed to the Fall 2011 term, or requesting that your admission application be withdrawn and the application fee be refunded.

Special notes for Cal State L.A.:

- The University will open applications for the Winter 2011 Quarter, and not for Spring 2011
- Applications during this time are being accepted from:
 - Domestic upper division transfer students
 - Domestic graduate students for select graduate programs (degree, credential, and certificate)
- Eligible students should apply online via www.csumentor.edu between August 1-31, 2010
- Applications will not be accepted from first-time freshmen, lower division transfer students or international students
- Fall 2010 coursework will not be considered for Winter 2011 admissions
