Admissions Information

What We Offer

The University offers a variety of majors leading to bachelor's and master's degrees in more than 50 fields. Average class size is 28, and students often have the opportunity to work directly with faculty on major research projects.

Cal State L.A. operates on the quarter system with four 11-week quarters (10 weeks of instruction and 1 week of exams).

The 175-acre hilltop campus is located five miles from Los Angeles' civic and cultural center, bordering the San Gabriel Valley and South Pasadena.

Admission Requirements

You will qualify as a lower-division transfer student if you have:

- Completed fewer than 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units) prior to the quarter to which you are applying.
- Minimum 2.0 transferable college GPA.
- Meet CSU freshman admission criteria:
 - Be a high school graduate.
 - Complete, with a 'C' or better, the 'A-G' subject requirements. May be satisfied using both high school and college courses.
 - Meet eligibility index using HS GPA and SAT RT/ACT scores.
- Good academic standing at the last college you attended.

You will qualify as an upper-division transfer student if you have:

- Completed 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units) prior to the quarter to which you are applying.
- Minimum 2.0 transferable college GPA (or 2.4 for non-CA residents).
- Completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) units of the general education requirements including Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking and Math/Quantitative Reasoning.
- Good academic standing at the last college you attended.

International Students

Any acceptable baccalaureate level course work must be completed with a grade point average of at least 2.40 (A=4.00). Applicants who have completed fewer than 60 transferable semester (or 90 quarter) units must also qualify for admission based on their high school record. A minimum TOEFL score of 61 (internet based); 173 (computer based); or 500 (paper based) is required of all undergraduate applicants who have not completed at least three years of coursework at the secondary level or above, where English is the principal language of instruction. To ensure timely notification, transcripts from overseas applicants must be received 60 days prior to the

first day of the term for which you are applying. For more information, visit www.calstatela.edu/univ/intlstu.

Applying to the University

Prospective transfer students applying for part-time or full-time undergraduate study must file a complete admission application before the posted deadline. We recommend that you apply online at www.csumentor.edu. Official transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities will be required.

An application fee of \$55 in U.S. funds, payable to the California State University, is required for each application filed. The fee is NON-REFUNDABLE and may not be transferred to another term at any campus. Fee waivers are available for those who qualify.

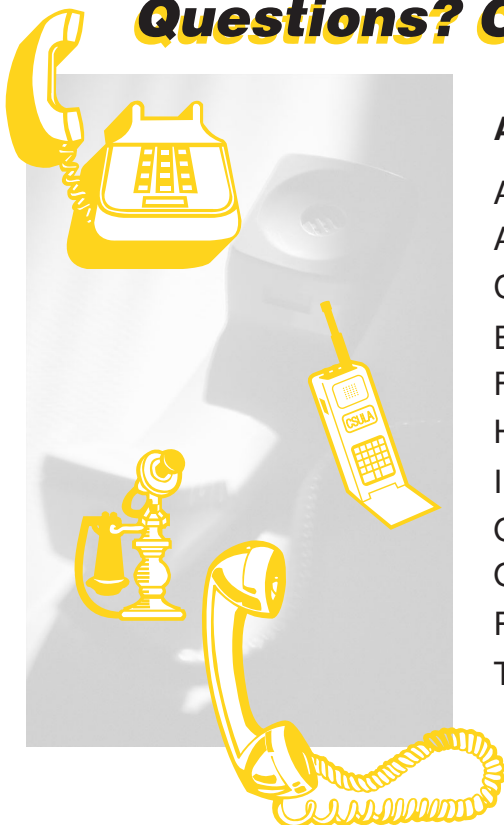
