### EARLY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (EAP) [www.collegeEAP.org](http://www.collegeEAP.org)

The EAP helps high school students meet college readiness standards in English and mathematics.

Exams are optional and are given in the spring of the 11th grade as part of the required California Standards Tests (CSTs). Eleventh graders will be notified of testing dates by their schools.

Benefits of participating in the EAP portion of the CST are:

- Students may be exempt from the English and Math placement exams, by receiving a qualifying score;
- Identify the need for additional preparation in English and math to succeed at the CSU while still enrolled in high school;
- Adjust senior-year coursework to prepare for the CSU; and
- Avoid spending time and money in college remediation courses that do not count toward a bachelor's degree.
