Essential Functions: Under the supervision of the project investigator, the incumbent conducts geochemical experiments as part of the project funded by the National Science Foundation. The project will further develop new isotope methods to monitor chromium contamination. This project will specifically measure isotope fractionation caused by conversion of trivalent chromium to hexavalent chromium.

Specific duties include but are not limited to: help conduct geochemical experiments with chromium; conduct analysis using spectrophotometer; assist with maintenance of the laboratory; assist with ordering supplies as needed for the experiment/laboratory; and performs other related duties as assigned.

Requirements: Must be a student currently attending Cal State L.A. A completed Student Employment application is required along with proof of course schedule to determine enrollment status and a copy of unofficial transcripts. Incumbent must have basic knowledge of chemistry/geology and ability to work in a laboratory. Incumbent must demonstrate an interest or ability in working in a multicultural/multiethnic environment. Fingerprinting will be taken and checked by the California Department of Justice and FBI.

Review of applications/resumes will begin February 23, 2012 and will continue until the position is filled; however, the position may close when an adequate number of qualified applications are received.
