Requirements: Must be a student currently attending Cal State L.A. A completed Student Employment application is required along with proof of course schedule to determine enrollment status and a copy of unofficial transcripts. Degree seeking student in Computer Science or Computer Information Systems with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. Incumbent must possess strong written and verbal communication skills; general knowledge of web development; and must demonstrate an interest or ability in working in a multicultural/multiethnic environment. Incumbent must have knowledge of HTML, JavaScript, AJAX, Cold Fusion, C#, ASP, NET, XML, Oracle, SQL Server, MS Access, and Cognos. Fingerprinting will be taken and checked by the California Department of Justice and FBI.
