Essential Functions: Under the general supervision of the Principal Investigator and faculty mentor, the incumbent offers the student additional opportunities to participate in research activities, mentoring relationships, and also provide financial opportunities to offset the costs of the program. Major function includes assisting faculty mentor with research project.

Percentage of time:

20% Proposal development; sample selection and recruitment

25% Data collection; instrument development and selection

25% Assist with data analysis

15% Preparation of reports

10% Preparation of manuscripts

5% Presentation of manuscripts at conferences; and other related duties as assigned.

Requirements: Must be a student currently attending Cal State L.A. in MSW or a Nursing graduate student in the Bridges to the PhD program. A completed Student Employment application is required along with proof of course schedule to determine enrollment status. The successful candidate will have the following requirements including proficiency in Microsoft Office, SSP, and Excel, and have knowledge of data base management and the internet. Ability to develop propels, collect and analyze data. The incumbent must also demonstrate an interest or ability in working in a multicultural/multiethnic environment.
